At the start of 2022 no-one was expecting the war in Ukraine. A large number of Ukrainian refugees arrived in Romania, and we received donations specifically to support that need. The majority of your gifts were sent to Hope Church in Craiova, who continue to care for approximately 60 refugees, provide transport for several hundreds more, and send monthly food convoys to Odessa in southern Ukraine. We have no further resources to help them in 2023.

Another new project for 2022 was to help support the work of Remus and Catea in the Republic of Moldova. They are carrying out humanitarian relief and church planting in two villages near the capital. We have also managed to link them up with a private sponsor, in addition to what is shown in our own accounts.

We continue to support our main project base in Teiuş with overhead costs for the kindergarten, and a food aid program for homeless and poor people.

Money for Corneşti was to support transport costs for mission and the summer holiday club at Şona. We also have a private sponsor for students from Corneşti, and mission in Şona, in addition to what is shown in our own accounts.

Bank costs have increased as the bank industry has withdrawn free banking to charities.

Material aid deliveries ceased at the end of 2020, due to Brexit and the UK leaving the EU Customs Union. No material aid please.
