



**NOVEMBER VISIT** My visit in November was to catch up on all the visiting that I had no time for during the August summer camp program. In Timișoara I received a warm welcome from the Elim church, and shared messages and stories with children and young people [photo above - leaders of teenagers]. At the kindergarten in Bagaciu [below] I did a morning observation, and learnt that the main cause of disruption is that the children have a poor attention span for listening. They need a constant stream of activities in the classroom. Although I had taken a large amount of materials



with me, the greatest joy from the teacher was to see 2 reams of photocopier paper that I had bought locally. This was a lesson for me that some of the best help is very simple. I helped with Saturday club at Șona. The message I took away from Teiuș was that of survival - to raise enough finance to pay for gas and electricity during the winter at the kindergarten. **Ed.**
