Para 1.20	<p>Brexit had a negative impact on the work of the charity, as all humanitarian aid deliveries ceased in 2020. The Covid pandemic in 2021 also reduced the opportunities for youth work. Our work contracted to the core locations of Teius and Cornesti.</p> <p>New opportunities arose in 2022: to help Ukrainian refugees in southern Romania through the work of Hope Church, Craiova; and to expand our work into the Republic of Moldova.</p> <p>Our core work remained centred on Teius, supporting overhead costs of a Christian kindergarten, and work with elderly homeless and poor families.</p>
