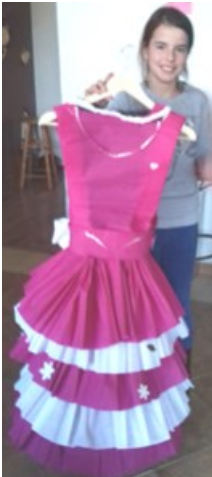
Disabled Children

We call this program "Parents for a Day" because one of the key benefits is to provide respite care for the parents.

We found sponsorship to buy tricycles for two disabled children. It is a dream that their parents could never afford, because this kind of bike is 400 Euros each in Romania. Daniel, 10 years old, was not able to ride a normal bike, because of deficiencies with his limbs. When we give him the bike he could not believe it is his! Ionut, 11 years old, has autism, and



in the last few years he took on a lot of weight, because of his sedentary lifestyle. He loves his bike a lot and he is using it all the day at home. We Praise the Lord for the money that we got to help them. We continue to pray for two more. One for Nicusor a boy with Downs Syndrome, and one to have at the foundation so they can ride in the yard when we meet with them. Emelia, 9 years old, suffers from epilepsy and we helped make her an eco-dress from paper for a competition at school.
