

MOLDOVA

From March 2022 we have sent support to Remus and Catea Trimbițaș based with Operation Mobilisation (OM) at Chișnau, Moldova. They are also involved in mission and humanitarian work in the villages of Pojareni and Vasieni.

In Poareni they have spent the last two months looking at options to buy a building as a base for their work. But what is currently for sale is either too big (= too expensive) or has insufficient ground outside for children’s games. So it is back to their original idea of buying a field and building something small.



Thanks to the Willmore family for contributing to Anatolie’s cataract operation. He can now see very well and is often out and about the village instead of isolated at home!

In Vasieni there is a mother with 5 children living in an animal shed, who are about to be evicted by the owner, who wants to sell the land for 2000 euros. Remus is currently working with the Mayor to confirm that the person trying to sell the land is indeed the owner, and that legal papers do exist for a sale. If everything is correct, he wants to raise the 2000 euros to buy the land and allow the family to stay.



REFUGEES At the start of the crisis Catea was based at the border crossing point for refugees coming into Moldova from Ukraine [left], and Remus was a volunteer driver transferring them to the Moldova-Romanian border crossing, where he would link-up with drivers from Teiuș for the onward journey into Romania. They also had a Ukrainian family come to

stay with them [right]. But as they were never at home this wasn’t going to work as a long term option. They now work daytime with refugees from the OM base in Chișnau, and have managed to rent accommodation for refugees in the city - as per situation described on page 7. Reach 2 Romania has sent £268 in support of the refugee work in Chișnau. **Ed.**
